Feast days - Moon phases - Working days - Saint observances

How to Use This Calendar

Every date below has been compiled from traditional African American Hoodoo and Catholic saint observances most commonly worked in the conjure tradition. Mark the dates that speak to your practice. You do not need to work every one - your ancestors will guide you to the days that matter most.

Moon phases are calculated for US Eastern Time. Adjust as needed for your location. **Saint feast days** follow the Roman Catholic calendar most familiar to Hoodoo practice.

January 2026

Date	Working
Jan 1	New Year - cleansing bath, road opener work, sweep the house out
Jan 3	First quarter moon - growth and increase work begins
Jan 6	Epiphany / Three Kings Day - blessings on the home
Jan 11	Full moon (Wolf Moon) - peak power, court case work, jar shake
Jan 17	Feast of St. Anthony the Abbot - protection of animals
Jan 20	New moon - banishing, uncrossing, freezer spells
Jan 28	First quarter moon - money work

February 2026

Date	Working
Feb 2	Candlemas - bless all candles for the year
Feb 9	Full moon (Snow Moon) - reveal hidden enemies
Feb 14	St. Valentine - love work, honey jars, sweetening
Feb 18	New moon - cut cords, banish bad habits
Feb 22	Chair of St. Peter - authority and leadership work
Feb 27	First quarter moon - drawing prosperity

March 2026

Date	Working
Mar 11	Full moon (Worm Moon) - awaken stagnant work
Mar 17	St. Patrick - banish snakes (gossip, deceit) from your life
Mar 19	St. Joseph - home blessing, fatherhood, employment
Mar 20	Spring Equinox - balance, fresh start altars
Mar 21	New moon - plant seeds (literal and spiritual)
Mar 28	First quarter moon - increase petitions

April 2026

Date	Working
Apr 5	Palm Sunday - bless palms for protection
Apr 9	Holy Thursday - foot washing, ancestor work
Apr 10	Good Friday - powerful day for crossing and uncrossing
Apr 12	Easter Sunday / Full moon (Pink Moon) - resurrection and renewal
Apr 19	Divine Mercy Sunday
Apr 19	Feast of St. Expedite - urgent needs, fast work, pound cake offering
Apr 20	New moon - new beginnings ritual

May 2026

Date	Working
May 1	May Day - flower offerings, fertility
May 8	Feast of St. Michael the Archangel (apparition) - protection
May 10	Full moon (Flower Moon) - full love work
May 13	Our Lady of Fatima - rosary work, mothers
May 19	New moon - banish what no longer serves
May 22	St. Rita - impossible cases

June 2026

Date	Working
Jun 9	Full moon (Strawberry Moon) - peak love and beauty
Jun 13	Feast of St. Anthony of Padua - lost things, fast money
Jun 19	Juneteenth - ancestor veneration, freedom work
Jun 21	Summer Solstice - sun-charged oils and waters
Jun 24	St. John the Baptist - one of the most important Hoodoo days; gather St. John herbs at sunrise
Jun 28	St. Peter - keys, opening doors, employment

July 2026

Date	Working
Jul 8	Full moon (Buck Moon) - protection work
Jul 16	Our Lady of Mount Carmel - scapular blessing
Jul 22	St. Mary Magdalene - womens mysteries, repentance
Jul 25	St. James the Greater (associated with Ogun in some traditions)
Jul 26	St. Anne - grandmothers, ancestor work

August 2026

Date	Working
Aug 7	Full moon (Sturgeon Moon) - abundance harvest
Aug 13	Feast of St. Cassian
Aug 15	Assumption of Mary - womens blessings
Aug 16	Marie Laveau Day (anniversary of her death) - leave offerings at her tomb or altar
Aug 30	St. Rose of Lima - love and protection of women

September 2026

Date	Working
Sep 6	Full moon (Corn Moon)
Sep 8	Nativity of Mary
Sep 14	Exaltation of the Holy Cross - protection workings using the cross
Sep 16	Feast of St. Cyprian - powerful magical patron
Sep 22	Autumn Equinox - balance
Sep 29	Feast of St. Michael, Gabriel, Raphael - archangel protection

October 2026

Date	Working
Oct 4	St. Francis of Assisi - blessing of animals
Oct 6	Full moon (Hunters Moon) - cut and clear
Oct 15	St. Teresa of Avila
Oct 31	All Hallows Eve - veil thinnest, ancestor altar work, cemetery visits

November 2026

Date	Working
Nov 1	All Saints Day - honor all the holy dead
Nov 2	All Souls Day - the most important ancestor day of the year; full meal on the altar
Nov 5	Full moon (Beaver Moon)
Nov 21	Presentation of Mary
Nov 22	Feast of St. Cecilia - music and creative work
Nov 30	St. Andrew - love divination night

December 2026

Date	Working
Dec 4	Full moon (Cold Moon)
Dec 8	Immaculate Conception
Dec 12	Our Lady of Guadalupe - mothers, healing, women
Dec 13	St. Lucy - light returning, eyesight
Dec 21	Winter Solstice - longest night, ancestor vigil
Dec 24	Christmas Eve - blessing of the home
Dec 25	Christmas - peace work
Dec 31	New Years Eve - cleansing for the year ahead

A Final Word

This calendar is a starting point - not a script. The dead keep their own time. Sit at your altar with a fresh glass of water and listen. They will tell you which days are yours.
